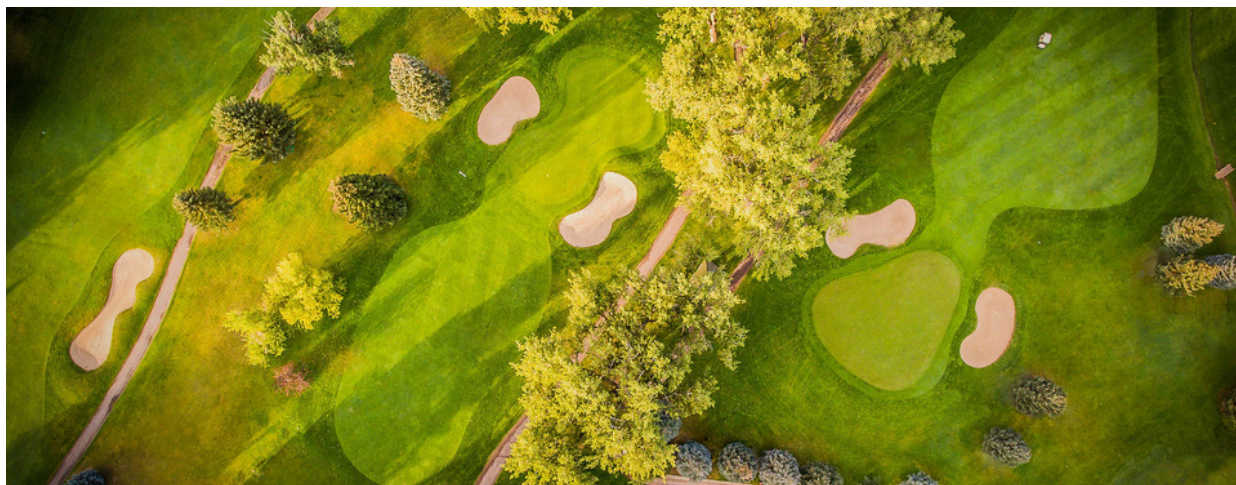

From The Superintendent

Welcome back for the 2026 golf season. Yeah, I'm still here. I hope the Winter was good to you. If we can even call it "Winter". Certainly was odd and not at all what I anticipated. I enjoy telling people I escaped the cold and snow of Pennsylvania by moving to Wyoming.

I wanted to give you a rundown of what we have going on this Spring season. Two huge accomplishments were cleaning up the course for opening day and turning on the irrigation. The crew did a fabulous job with clean up. Winter winds had the course looking like a tornado had hit. Removing that much debris was quite an undertaking, but they succeeded. By April 11th Devin had water throughout the course. Impressive since we only received the water on April 8th. We began irrigating immediately to overcome the extreme winter drought.

The tree project continues. The last of the stumps were ground this past Thursday and we're moving onto cleanup, leveling, and either seeding or sodding. Reaction has been surprisingly positive. We all look forward to there being grass in areas that were dirt and roots. I personally love the new view of #10 and 15 greens. Such a nice change from just another green boxed in by a wall of spruce.

Another improvement underway is the addition of irrigation specifically targetting the green surrounds. It was an area of weakness that really drew my attention last season. We all know that no turfgrass can tolerate our summer heat, drought, and low humidity without irrigation. Our greens were beautiful and all around them, dried out. These new sprinklers will allow us to irrigate the surrounds without adding more water to the putting surfaces. By the time you read this #4 and #10 greens will be complete. We will continue with #13, 12, and 8, and beyond in 2027.

Throughout the winter, Mike Pertile built us the new steps for numbers 12, 13, and 16. They look great. If you see him, say thanks. We have the areas prepped with topsoil and will be sodding around them as soon as sod is available.

A small but important addition worthy of mention is the new light shining on our nation's flag. It is important to our club, our veterans, and my crew. We're glad to finally have it in place. Check it out if you're at the club after dark.

You can probably tell, Spring is about getting the course open and projects. We have a lot going on and more on the way. New bunker sand is in our future. Of course, we are still trying to give you the best possible conditions daily. But you already know that. Most everyone is enjoying the early Spring conditions this year. If you haven't golfed yet, you should.
